The U.S. Office of Naval Research (ONR) provides opportunities for funding to support innovative basic research at non-U.S. universities and institutions through its Global office (ONR Global). Areas of interest cover a wide range of foundational science, with the aim of furthering the body of knowledge in the field by encouraging and facilitating open-literature publication. The research topics should be innovative, and may be high risk with high potential payoff.

This talk will provide an overview of ONR Global, their opportunities for support, instructions for applying, and a list of topics of interest. The intent is to advance the science, fill gaps in knowledge, transfer the knowledge, and facilitate the development of early-career scientists. Opportunities for support include research grants, visiting scientist exchanges, conferences/workshops, and Global-X, an annual accelerated research challenge in specific topics.
